Constitution Amendments

Below is a list of changes to the constitution. A copy of the current and proposed constitutions are also attached.

The FSAA committee proposes the special resolution that the new constitution be accepted. A vote will take place at the AGM by a show of hands using the meeting feature. A majority of 51% will carry the special resolution with the new constitution taking effect immediately.

There will be allotted time prior to voting to raise questions in relation to the changes. The changes will either all be accepted or all declined.

 - (b) Requiring the conflicted member to abstain from a particular vote; or
 - (c) By resolution, removing the conflicted member from office."
